

## BILL MIZEN MEMORIAL AUDAX TROPHY

The trophy is awarded to the member riding the greatest total distance in regulation audax events during the year regardless of type and number of events.

The history of the trophy - Bill passed away in March 1995. He was a past president of the Club having joined in 1934 after moving from London. He ran a cycle business producing cycles carrying his name up until the war. With A.Raby they were prolific on the tandem and after signing a professional contract, they broke several long distance records. Following the war and wrangles with the NCU and RTTC, and subsequently denied the return of his amateur status, Bill devoted his energies to the Club's successful post war development. Awarded life membership in 1946 he spent the last 3 years of his life researching and producing an illustrated book covering the early decades of the Club's history. A new trophy was proposed at the 1995 Half Year General Meeting to promote and encourage members to ride long distance audax events. Later in 1995, the committee decided it appropriate to dedicate this trophy to Bill's memory.
