The trophy is awarded to the winner of the Club Burton Dasset hill climb (since 1992).

History of the trophy - Dick Precious who passed away in 1991, was a well known RTTC and club timekeeper for many years. He was a life member of the Godiva R. & P.C. so when the two clubs merged in 1967, Dick was invited to continue his life membership with the Road Club. The club hill climb was revived in 1984, an end of season social event in which Dick always enjoyed the timekeeping duties. In 1992 the Club decided to present a trophy for this event dedicated to Dick's memory and for many years his widow Violet presented the trophy on the day. The Club subsequently made Violet an honorary member of the Club.
